



Hoodwinker Sunfish

The largest hoodwinker sunfish on record can be found in the foyer of the Museum. Sunfish are the heaviest bony fish in the world, sometimes weighing over 2,000 kg! They use their small beak-like mouths to slurp up salps and jellyfish, which are their favourite foods.
